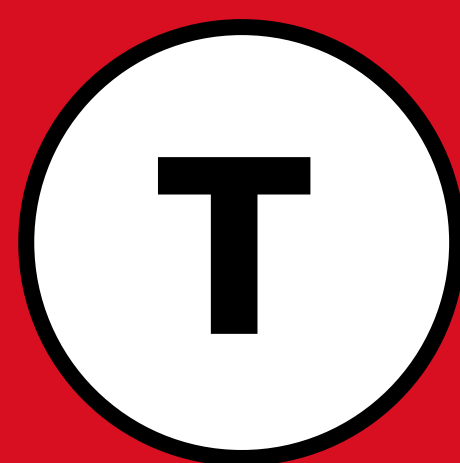
ANY KIND OF INFECTION CAN LEAD TO SEPSIS

Some common infections that can lead to sepsis include:

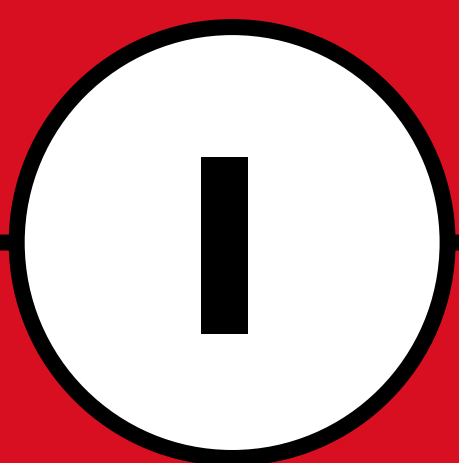
- **URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS (UTIs)**
- **STREP THROAT** • **INFLUENZA** • **MRSA**

- **Sepsis is your body's life-threatening response to an infection.**
 - **Sepsis is usually easy to treat if it is detected early.**
 - **Sepsis kills 270,000 people each year in the U.S.**

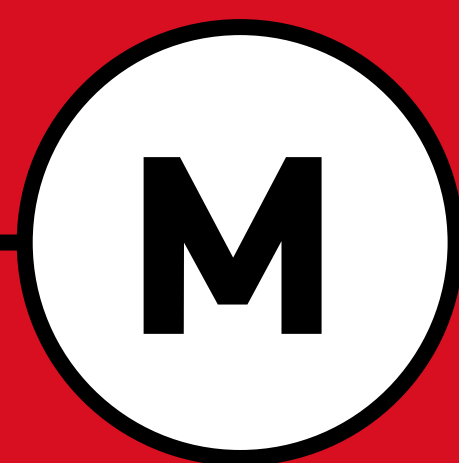
If you've had an infection or suspect an infection, and develop a combination of these symptoms, seek medical attention right away:



TEMPERATURE
higher or lower than
normal



INFECTION
may have signs or
symptoms of infection



MENTAL DECLINE
confused, sleepy,
difficult to rouse



EXTREMELY ILL
severe pain,
discomfort, shortness
of breath
